



# Miss Basinger's First Grade Newsletter March 9, 2017

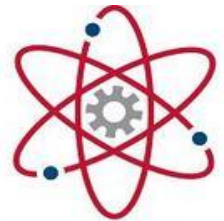


## This is what we studied:
