



- Friday we learned about reflection and refraction, prisms, and the human eye (how we see light). We explored spectroscopes, flashlights, colored lenses and mirrors.
- Monday was a blast! Kaycee's dad woks for Allegiance Credit Union, and he and his coworkers came to visit Monday morning to talk to us about the importance of saving money. The kids all got a piggy bank and a quarter to start saving at home, a coupon, a sticker, and they met Earnie the eagle. This all tied in perfectly with our Nickels + Pennies collection graph.
